

Thursday 13th Sept. U11B v KISU @ KISU and U11G v KISU @ KISU



Message from the Head of School

Preparing a child for a world that doesn't yet exist is not an easy task for any teacher. We are continuously thinking about what the critical 21st Century skills might be that every student needs in order to survive and be successful in tomorrow's world? What skills, abilities and traits will serve them well in a time that is changing and developing so rapidly? Educationists, in the broadest sense of the word, have come up with what are known as the 4C's - critical thinking, communication, collaboration and creativity as being the keys to the future.

Through both curricular and extra curricular activities teachers at Ambrosoli endeavour to enable our pupils to develop the skills that they will need to have happy and fulfilled lives.

Through the use of the International Primary Curriculum (IPC), which the school has now been using for five years, we are certain that we are giving the children at our school the best opportunities possible to become active, engaged and internationally minded 21st century learners with a genuine love of learning and enquiry.



This school year Ambrosoli is hoping to achieve its accreditation from Fieldwork Education, the parent company of the IPC. Next Friday a pre accreditation visitor from IPC will spend the day in school assessing how well the school and its community understand the philosophy and application of the

curriculum. During the day she will meet with children, teachers, parents and governors as well as spending time in classrooms looking at learning. She will then acknowledge the things that we are doing well and leave us with some recommendations for further improvement. The following day will be a training day for the teachers and, finally, in May 2019 an accreditation team will visit to assess our readiness for accreditation. This is another exciting development for our school and its community. If you are in school on Friday and you come across our special visitor please do feel free to stop and have a chat. I'm sure she is anxious to get feedback from as wide a range of our community as possible - I am quite certain that your children will have plenty to share with her too!
