Finally, a recap on the Financial Policies;

FINANCIAL POLICIES RECAP (2018-19):

1. There are 3 Modes of Payment;
 - Total Annual Invoice (Standard / All Inclusive)
 - Total Termly Invoice (Standard /All Inclusive)
 - 10 Monthly Installments - (10 Post dated Cheques or Standing Orders with a Ugandan Bank).
1. There is a 10% Penalty charged on Outstanding Fees after the deadline shown on your invoices and in the Newsletter has passed.
2. The Exchange rate used will be in the Newsletter every week otherwise please confirm with the Accounts office.
3. No student will be readmitted into the subsequent term if they have an

outstanding balance on fees from the previous term.

4. No Family will be allowed in school if their outstanding balance exceeds an equivalent of 1 child's Terms' Fees.
5. No Family will receive their children's end of year report until such a time that their balance is nil.
6. No Cash Policy - Cash Limit of UGX 100,000- all payments should be made directly into the schools Bank Account.
