

Message from the Head of School


Having responsibility for the learning of young children has always been a huge responsibility, but never more so that at the present. As a teaching staff we spend considerable time discussing and reflecting on our 21st Century learners and how we can best prepare Ambrosoli children for what is a somewhat unpredictable future. The International Primary Curriculum (IPC) which is used at our school is a curriculum that has really thought hard about the future of education and has designed its curriculum to be brain friendly (taking into account the latest neurological research) and to make sure that in addition to the **knowledge** that primary school aged children require to be successful that equal importance is given to the **skills** necessary to apply the learning in a variety of contexts and through which the children progress through beginning, developing and mastering and from the simple to the more complex and to **understanding** which depends on the depth of experiences offered to the children and to supported opportunities for reflection and personal responses.

The curriculum uses Units of work which encompass all curriculum areas - science, geography, history, international, social and whenever possible art, music, PE and French. Our teachers are also very adept at planning their English curriculum to support the children learning through the IPC too.

I will have a variety of IPC units available for you to look at during our meet the SLT coffee meeting at 8am on Wednesday morning so if you would like to have a look and learn more about your children's learning do come along. I look forward to seeing you there.
